Today, May 14, 2003, the Bureau received an Order from the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania advising the Secretary of the Commonwealth that the Allegheny County Election Division is ordered not to report and/or certify the votes received by Wrenna Leigh Watson, a candidate for the office of Judge of the Court of Common Pleas in the 5th Judicial District (Allegheny County) on the May 20, 2003 Municipal Primary ballot.

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 201 (c) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, at 25 P. S. § 2621 (c), the primary ballot certification mailed to you on April 14, 2003 by Acting Secretary of the Commonwealth Pedro A. Cortés is hereby amended, removing the name of Wrenna Leigh Watson as a Democratic candidate for the office of Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, 5th Judicial District (Allegheny County).
