It is hereby

ORDERED THAT: by 4:00 p.m., Monday, October 18, 2004, the defendant shall supplement his pending motion to dismiss by submitting:

1. As exhibits to that motion:

- a. An affidavit setting forth his reading of the following language from Secretary of State Directive 2004-7, including whether “acceptable proof of identity” includes oral recitation, without documentary proof, of the last four digits of the voter’s social security number:

If the statement of affirmation has been properly completed and signed, and the voter provides acceptable proof of identity to either the board

office or to the precinct election officials by the time the polls close, then the ballot will be included in the official canvass.

b. A copy or poster(s) containing language pertaining to proof of identity by voters covered by Directive 2004-7 that are to be displayed at polling places in Ohio in the November 2, 2004, election; and

2. As a supplement to his brief in support of his pending motion to dismiss, citation to the source, if any, of the language pertaining to proof of identity in Directive 2004-7 and the poster(s) being submitted in accordance with this Order.
