

1. Ohio's Loitering Statutes, Ohio Rev. Code §§ 3501.30, 3501.35 and 3599.24, cannot be interpreted to prohibit exits polls within the 100 foot designated area around polling places without violating the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.
2. It would be unlawful and a violation of the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution to interpret, apply or enforce Ohio's election Loitering Statutes, Ohio Rev. Code §§ 3501.30, 3501.35, and 3599.24 to prohibit exit polls within 100 feet of the polling places.
3. The Court permanently enjoins the Secretary of State and all those acting in concert with him from enforcing or issuing any rule, directive, advisory, policy or communication that would prohibit exit polls within the 100 foot designated area around polling places.
