Personally appeared before me, the undersigned authority in and for the State and County aforesaid, the within named **SHIRLEY BLAKELY**, member of the Noxubee County Democratic Executive Committee, and would state the following:

1. I acted as Secretary for the Noxubee County Democratic Executive Committee for the canvassing of the August 7, 2007 Primary Election results on August 9 and 10, 2007.
2. No candidate complained about the electoral process, except for George Robinson, incumbent black Supervisor for District 3, who was defeated by another black candidate for that office. He complained that the poll workers, who had a substantial number of whites, were biased against him. He has made no written complaint.
3. There were no complaints from voters.
4. There were 1,110 absentee ballots submitted out of a total of approximately 4,950 votes cast.
5. Neither Ike Brown, nor any member of the Noxubee County Democratic Executive

Committee, appeared as witness or notary for any of these absentee ballots. Nevertheless, the number of ballots were equivalent to the prior primary election of 2003, when one takes into account that one of the five Supervisor Districts (20% of voters) was uncontested.

6. Attached as Exhibit "A" are the minutes of the Noxubee County Democratic Executive Committee during the 2007 Democratic Primary canvassing process.

7. Attached as Exhibit "B" is an election summary report for the 2007 primary elections in Noxubee County, Mississippi.

8. There were 108 absentee ballots rejected by the poll managers. Of that number, nine were by known white voters, 96 by known black voters, and three were persons whose race was unknown.

9. The number of rejected absentee ballots was high in substantial part because a significant number of persons who had voted absentee, probably solicited by candidates, appeared to vote in person, often solicited by other candidates, which void the absentee ballot.

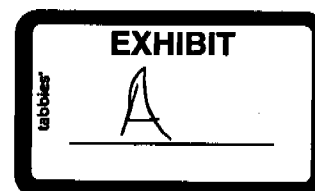

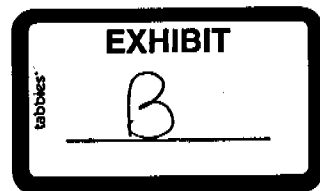
