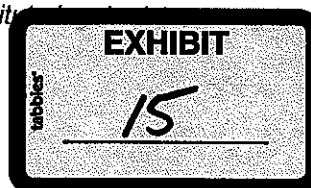
For the most part that is the purpose. It is difficult for BVRS to perform verification of those files without images. Most times the record is unable to be verified because of a data entry error at the time of input (i.e., misspelled names and number transpositions); with an image those applications can be corrected, verified through DAVE and then overridden. Without an image of the actual application it is difficult/impossible to verify.
