ORDER

The Court conferred with counsel for the parties, by telephone, on October 26, 2015 regarding certain discovery and scheduling matters. It is **ORDERED** as follows:

Defendants will produce to plaintiffs the data obtained by them or their agents from the relevant county elections boards or agencies.

The Court will not permit plaintiffs to produce supplemental expert reports.

Despite their diligence in attempting to meet the discovery completion date, the parties have not been able to do so. Under these circumstances, defendants may conduct a Rule 30(b)(6) deposition of the Ohio Democratic Party on November 2, 2015, and plaintiffs may depose the three (3) remaining declarants (for no more than two (2) hours per deposition) at a time agreeable with the deponents during the week of November 2, 2015. Plaintiffs may depose defendants' expert, Dr. McCarty, on November 9, 2015. However, this extended discovery may under no circumstances serve to undermine the viability of the scheduled final pretrial conference or trial date.

It is so ordered.
