ORDERED THAT:

1. Leave granted to plaintiffs to file an amended complaint by November 30, 2005.
2. Defendants' motion to dismiss filed November 14, 2006, overruled without prejudice to re-file motion challenging amendments to plaintiffs' complaint; said motion to dismiss, if any, to be filed by December 30, 2005, opposition to be filed by January 15, 2006, reply due January 31, 2006;
3. Motion to stay discovery overruled over defendants' objection, without prejudice to defendants' right to assert Eleventh Amendment sovereign immunity challenge, to extent not previously waived;

4. Documents as to which privilege(s) is/are claimed to be produced under seal for *in camera* inspection by noon, Wednesday, November 30, 2005;
  5. Telephonic discovery conference, if needed, to be held December 2, 2005, at 2:00 p.m. parties to submit summary statement re. discovery disputes by 4:00 p.m., December 1, 2005.
