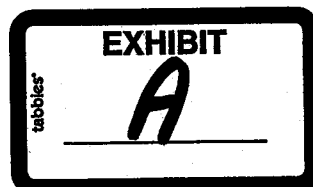

Dear Ed:

If you will recall, at the deposition of Mrs. Allsup held June 15, 2006, at the beginning of the deposition, and on the record, I registered an objection to the Subpoena which was served on Mrs. Allsup the previous Saturday, June 10, 2006, stating that the request was overly burdensome and that Mrs. Allsup did not have time prior to the deposition to gather the records. I further objected for the reason that the required witness fee and mileage was not tendered to Mrs. Allsup at the time of service. Having registered this objection, I presented Mrs. Allsup voluntarily with the agreement that she would attempt to search for the records and present them to both you and the Government when she had time to gather the records. I further stated that some of the records requested by Subpoena were not in existence. You, and Wil Colom, were in agreement to such a procedure and we proceeded with the deposition.

As you know, Mrs. Allsup does not have control of the records. Mrs. Alice Cooper, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Noxubee County Republican Party, has primary custody of the records. Mrs. Cooper's husband died on September 27-30, after a lengthy bout with cancer. As you can imagine, Mrs. Cooper has been going through an emotional time during this period.



Mrs. Allsup has done her best to gather what records she can find subject to your Subpoena and I enclose these records for your review.
