The parties are directed to file concurrent supplemental briefs directed to the issue of how, if at all, Washington Laws of 2009, chapter 325 (HB 1517), affects this appeal, including whether, as of its effective date, July 26, 2009, HB 1517 will render this appeal and the action moot. The parties shall also address whether, if this appeal is not moot, this case should be remanded to the district court for that court to examine, in the first instance, the effect of HB 1517 on this action.

Said supplemental briefs shall not exceed 15 pages or 4200 words and shall be submitted no later than May 29, 2009. Parties who are registered for ECF must file the supplemental brief electronically without submission of paper copies.

Parties who are not registered for ECF must file the original supplemental brief plus 15 paper copies.
