
DECLARATION OF KIM HERON

I, Kim Heron, declare as follows:

1. I am the Editor of the Metro Times newspaper.
2. The Metro Times has run several stories about the Michigan Presidential Primary which was held on January 15, 2008.
3. An ongoing issue of concern to many of our readers is the subject of “crossover” voting in Michigan primaries.
4. Examination of the party preference designations of the persons who voted in the January 15, 2008 Michigan Presidential Primary would be useful in determining if there was any widespread crossover voting in the Primary, as that information would indicate if elected officials, party officials, known activists and contributors of one party voted in the other party’s primary.

5. If the Metro Times were not prohibited by statute from using the party preference information, we would examine portions of it as the basis for stories on crossover voting and related matters.
6. If the Metro Times were provided with this information from persons authorized to use it, we would refrain from using it in any story because of the law's threat of criminal penalties for such use.
7. I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
