THIS CAUSE comes before the Court on Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Injunction, filed May 14, 2008. ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction is **GRANTED**; and

THE COURT DECLARES AS FOLLOWS:

Defendants and their employees, agents, representatives, and successors in office are preliminarily enjoined from enforcing the provisions of Fla. Stat. §§ 97.021(36) and 97.0575 regulating the voter registration activities of third-party voter registration organizations and any rules promulgated by the Florida Department of State and the Florida Division of Elections implementing those provisions.

In accordance with Rule 65(d) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Defendants **ARE FURTHER INSTRUCTED** to provide actual notice of this Order to their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all those in active concert and participation with them, so as to assure compliance.
