[PROPOSED] JOINT SCHEDULING ORDER

It is hereby stipulated and agreed, by and among counsel to the parties, subject to the approval of the Court, that subsequent to the hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, the parties shall proceed on the following schedule:

1. The case shall be assigned to the Standard Case Management Track, pursuant to Local Rule 16.1.A.

2. The parties shall submit a joint stipulation and proposed order to the Court governing the protection and exchange of confidential information, including claims of inadvertent production, no later than October 17, 2008.

3. The parties may not file a motion seeking to join other parties or amend the pleadings later than November 14, 2008.

4. Written discovery, including the production of electronically stored documents, shall be completed by December 15, 2008. The parties shall produce electronically stored documents either in their native format, in printed paper form, or as otherwise agreed to by the parties.
5. Deposition discovery of fact witnesses shall commence no earlier than January 5, 2009 and shall be concluded by March 5, 2009.
6. The parties shall exchange their opening expert report(s) by April 6, 2009.
7. The parties shall exchange any expert rebuttal report(s) by May 8, 2009.
8. Deposition discovery of expert witnesses shall be concluded by June 19, 2009.
9. Any motions for summary judgment shall be filed no later than July 24, 2009.
10. The parties shall serve and file all pre-trial motions by _____.
11. The Court shall resolve all pre-trial motions no later than _____.
12. The pre-trial conference will be held on _____ at _____.
13. Trial in the captioned action will be held on _____, commencing at _____ each day as necessary, in Miami, Florida.
