ORDERED as follows:

1. Jury selection is set for April 4, 2011. The trial of this case is set during the trial term commencing on April 4, 2011 before United States District Judge Myron H. Thompson and is expected to last eight weeks.
2. There are motions currently pending and the time set by the court for filing motions has been extended.
3. The court will not consider a plea pursuant to Rule 11(c)(1)(A) or (C) unless notice is filed on or before noon on March 23, 2011. The government and defendant are informed that if a defendant waits until the last minute to enter a plea, and if that plea, for whatever reason is not accepted by the court, the defendant and the government will be expected to be prepared to go to trial on April 4, 2011. The court will not continue the trial of this case as to any defendant because a defendant's plea was not accepted. In other words, the defendant and the government should not wait until the last minute for a defendant to enter a guilty plea, and both the defendant and the government should all be ready to go to trial on April 4, 2011, as to all defendants, even

though a particular guilty plea was not accepted by the court.

4. This case is set for a final pretrial conference on March 21, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. in Courtroom 2B. The clerk is to provide a court reporter for this conference.
