**DEFENDANT ROBERT GEDDIE’S MOTION TO SUPPRESS**

Defendant Robert Geddie respectfully requests that the Court suppress all wiretap recordings and any evidence that the Government has derived from them. In support of this request, Geddie incorporates by reference the contents, arguments, and authorities of Defendant Milton McGregor’s Motion to Suppress and his accompanying Brief and Evidentiary Exhibits and further states as follows:

1. Geddie has statutory standing to request that the Court suppress all wiretap recordings that captured his communications. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 2518(10)(a); 18 U.S.C. § 2510(11).
2. The Government’s interceptions, including those involving Geddie, stretched beyond judicial authorization.
3. Having failed to pursue meaningfully any effort at minimization, the monitoring agents violated the law and the instructions regarding the range of permissible conversations to intercept, to review, and to record.
4. Expansively and arbitrarily designating innocuous telephone calls as “pertinent” resulted in an overly-broad and unreasonable interception of subsequent telephone calls,

including those involving Geddie, which violated the law.

In short, the Government systematically failed to minimize interceptions. Accordingly, Defendant Geddie respectfully requests that the Court suppress all wiretap recordings and any evidence that the Government derived from those recordings.
