**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT MACOMB COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY'S
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION OF
ITS MOTION TO DISMISS**

This matter is before the Court on the defendant Macomb County Republican Party's motion to expedite consideration of its motion to dismiss, filed on October 8, 2008. Already pending before the Court are the plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction and two motions to dismiss filed by the defendants Michigan Republican Party and Republican National Committee. The hearing on all three motions is scheduled to take place on October 20, 2008.

The Macomb County Republican Party requests this Court to consider its own motion to dismiss at the same time as it considers the other defendants' motions and to follow the same briefing schedule as is established for the other defendants' motions. The Macomb County Republican Party suggests that its request is appropriate because the issues raised in its motion to

dismiss are similar to the ones the other two defendants raised, and the defendant obtained concurrence from the plaintiffs. The Court finds that the request is reasonable.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the defendant Macomb County Republican Party's motion for expedited consideration of motion to dismiss [dkt # 29] is **GRANTED**.

It is further **ORDERED** that the plaintiffs are to file response to the Macomb County Republican Party's motion to dismiss on or before **October 10, 2008**. Because the grounds stated in all dismissal motions are similar, the plaintiffs may file a combined response to the three defendants' motions if they wish.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Macomb County Republic Party may file a reply brief in support of its motion to dismiss on or before **October 13, 2008**.¹ If the plaintiffs file a combined response, the defendants must file a single combined reply brief. All briefs must comply with Local Rule 7.1(c).

It is further **ORDERED** that the parties may engage in discovery on the jurisdictional issues.

It is further **ORDERED** that the hearing on the defendant Macomb County Republican Party's motion to dismiss [dkt # 30] shall take place on **October 20, 2008** following the hearing on the motion for preliminary injunction.
