ORDER

Upon consideration of the several discovery motions filed by Defendant McGregor (Docs. #67-72), it is

ORDERED that the Motions (Docs. #67-72) are DENIED, without prejudice. Defendant admits in his Notice (Doc. #73), that he did not meet the conditions precedent to filing the discovery motions. Further, the motions are premature. As stated in the Standing Order on Criminal Discovery (Cr.
