ORDER

Pending before the Court are the *Objections of Defendant Quinton T. Ross, Jr. to Magistrate Judge's Orders Regarding Conditions of Pretrial Release, and Renewed Motions to Amend Conditions of Release* (Doc. 179, filed 11/02/10), *Tom Coker's Appeal of the Magistrate's Order Concerning Coker's Request for Modification to the Order Setting Conditions of Release*, (Doc. 190, filed 11/4/10), *the Notice of Proposed Agreement* (Doc. 195, filed 11/5/10), and the *Notice of Proposed Agreement* (Doc. 196, filed 11/5/10). The Court construes the Objections of Defendant Quinton T. Ross, Jr., and Tom Coker's Appeal (Docs. 179 and 190) as Motions to Reconsider. After consideration of the arguments and proposed agreements, the Court **GRANTS** the Motions to Reconsider and adopts the terms

set out in the Notice of Proposed Agreement. Further the Court directs that the Order Setting Conditions of Release (Doc. 55, filed 10/4/10) **for each defendant indicted in this cause** be revised to remove condition (w) in its entirety and to amend condition (j) to state:” the defendant must avoid all contact, directly or indirectly, with any witness related to the subject matter of the indictment with the intent to discuss matters contained in the indictment, unless the communication is made in the presence of defendant’s counsel and in preparation for trial. The defendant may engage in communications with any person regarding matters not alleged in the pending indictment”.
