ORDER

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction [# 2]. The Court **DIRECTS** the parties to appear for a hearing on Wednesday, October 22, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. at the United States Courthouse, 75 Spring Street, Atlanta, Georgia, Courtroom 2306. At the hearing, the three judge court will hear argument and receive evidence, if any, on whether a preliminary injunction should issue. The Court will impose time limits on each party's presentation. Thus, the parties are encouraged to rely to the extent possible on documentary evidence susceptible to admission, including affidavits.

The parties are **INSTRUCTED** to electronically file with the Court, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 20, 2008, a list of witnesses expected to be called, including a summary of the anticipated testimony, or any

documentary evidence or affidavits expected to be relied upon at the hearing. In addition, the parties are **INSTRUCTED** to file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law by this date. To the extent possible, each proposed finding of fact shall cite with particularity the evidence supporting such fact. In addition, each proposed conclusion of law shall cite applicable legal authority.
