Pursuant to Rule 15(d) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiffs respectfully move for leave to file *instanter* a Supplemental Complaint. Plaintiffs seek to add three new Plaintiffs, plead new factual allegations relating to occurrences and events that happened after the date on which the Complaint was filed, supplement their existing claims accordingly, assert new claims based on those occurrences, and plead their claims in conformance with *Crawford v. ## MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Plaintiffs respectfully move for leave to file *instanter* a Supplemental Complaint under Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, which states in pertinent part:

On motion and reasonable notice, the court may, on just terms, permit a party to serve a supplemental pleading setting out any transaction, occurrence, or event that happened after the date of the pleading to be supplemented. The court may permit supplementation even though the original pleading is defective in stating a claim or defense. The court may order that the opposing party plead to the supplemental pleading within a specified time.

Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(d)

The proposed Supplemental Complaint adds three new plaintiffs. Individual Plaintiffs Kyle Wangler and James Wise are homeless registered voters who intend to vote on Election Day but do not have, and cannot obtain, any of the forms of the required identification, and so must cast a provisional ballot. Plaintiff Columbus Coalition for the Homeless, which actively assists its homeless members and other homeless persons to register to vote and cast their votes, has homeless members who lack the required identification and so must also cast a provisional ballot on Election Day.

When Plaintiffs first brought this action in 2006, one of their claims was based on their belief that provisional ballots would inevitably be treated unequally by Ohio's eighty-eight Boards of Elections. The parties addressed that issue in a Consent Order (Doc. No. 51) that, among other things, sought to ensure the uniformity of the Provisional Ballot Laws when applied to determining which provisional ballots were eligible to be counted.

As shown by the facts pled in the Supplemental Complaint, it is now clear that Ohio's eighty-eight Boards of Elections did apply different and unequal standards when determining

which of the provisional ballots that were cast were eligible to be counted. These facts establish, at a minimum, a realistic danger that Boards of Elections will similarly apply different and unequal standards when evaluating provisional ballots cast in the November 2008 Election. Accordingly, Plaintiffs seek leave to file a Supplemental Complaint that pleads the necessary factual and legal allegations to allow them to obtain preliminary injunctive relief.

Plaintiffs further seek leave to file a Supplemental Complaint that pleads facts and claims in conformance with the United States Supreme Court's decision in *Crawford v. Marion County*, \_\_\_ U.S. \_\_\_, 128 S. Ct. 1610 (2008). Finally, Plaintiffs seek to add new claims that are based on the foregoing factual allegations.

For all of the foregoing reasons, Plaintiffs respectfully move this Court for leave to file *instanter* their proposed Supplemental Complaint, which is attached as Exhibit A. A proposed Order is attached as Exhibit B.
