**ORDER FOR ENTRY OF JUDGMENT
IN FAVOR OF SECRETARY OF STATE**

Plaintiffs have failed to file an amended complaint against the defendant Secretary of State. The deadline for doing so has passed. Accordingly, for the reasons set forth in the order entered December 14, 2007 (document 31), judgment now should be entered dismissing with prejudice plaintiffs' claims against the Secretary. Because judgment was previously entered against the other defendants under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(b), the judgment that will be entered dismissing the claims against the Secretary will be a Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58 judgment finally disposing of all remaining claims among all parties.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED:

The clerk shall enter judgment under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58 stating, “All remaining claims in this action are dismissed with prejudice.”
