**ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court on the parties' requests for extensions of time in which to submit their proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, and other matters.

The Court grants a fourteen-day (14) extension of time to run through April 9, 2007, in which each party may submit its proposed findings and conclusions. Any party may submit its proposed findings and conclusions before the April 9, 2007 date. The proposed findings and conclusions shall be initially submitted only to the undersigned Judge. On or before April 9,

2007, when all parties have submitted their proposed findings and conclusions, the parties will then confer telephonically, affirm that all have submitted their respective proposed findings and conclusions, and then serve all other parties with the same.

Further, during this telephonic conference, the parties will inform each other whether they intend to submit a rebuttal to the opposing parties' proposed findings and conclusions. If the parties determine during the telephonic conference that no party intends to submit a rebuttal, they will inform the Court immediately. If any of the parties decide to submit a rebuttal, it must be submitted no later than April 19, 2007.
