**ORDER VACATING AND RESETTING
TRIAL AND PRETRIAL CONFERENCE**

THIS MATTER comes before the Court *sua sponte* following the entry of stipulated orders [Doc. 73, 84] extending the deadlines for completion of briefing on the parties' cross-motions for summary judgment and suspending the filing of a final pretrial order while the cross-motions are pending. Having considered the parties' submissions, the relevant law, and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds that there is good cause for vacating and rescheduling the pretrial conference and trial dates in this matter to accord with the suspension of the deadline for filing the final pretrial order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the **PRETRIAL CONFERENCE** previously scheduled for Tuesday, January 2, 2007, at 9:00 a.m. is hereby **VACATED** and **RESET** for Tuesday, February 6, 2007, at 9:00 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **CALL OF THE CALENDAR** previously scheduled for Thursday, February 8, 2007, at 9:00 a.m. is hereby **VACATED** and **RESET** for Thursday, March 8, 2007, at 9:00 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **BENCH TRIAL** previously scheduled for Tuesday, February 13, 2007, is hereby **VACATED** and **RESET** for Tuesday, March 13, 2007, at 9:00 a.m. on a trailing docket.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other pretrial deadlines previously established in this case (except for the final pretrial order deadline) shall remain in full force and effect.
