TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction (Doc. 3). The Court finds that a Temporary Restraining Order is necessary in this case with respect to Advisory 2008-24 and therefore Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is **GRANTED IN PART**.

The Court therefore enters a Temporary Restraining Order requiring Defendant Ohio Secretary of State Jennifer Brunner to rescind Advisory 2008-24. Accordingly, Advisory 2008-24 has no effect and cannot be enforced to prevent observers from attending such locations that facilitate same-day registration, application for absent voter's ballot and ballot casting.

It is further ordered that the Plaintiffs are not required to post a bond.

It is further ordered that this Temporary Restraining Order shall expire within 10 days after entry pursuant to Rule 65(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
