ORDER

This case is before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for a Hearing on Plaintiffs' Second Motion for Preliminary Injunction in Advance of the September Special Elections [137].

The Court **ORDERS** the parties to appear before the Court for a brief evidentiary hearing concerning Plaintiffs' request for a preliminary injunction with respect to the September 2006 special elections on Thursday, September 14, 2006, at 1:30

p.m. The Court anticipates that the September 14, 2006, hearing will be brief, and cautions the parties that the Court does not intend to re-hear evidence previously presented by the parties at the previous two preliminary injunction hearings. Such evidence remains before the Court for its consideration. Instead, evidence presented at the September 14, 2006, hearing should relate to the State Defendants' educational efforts concerning the 2006 Photo ID Act, the number of Georgia registered voters who potentially lack a Photo ID, and the number of Voter ID cards issued.
