ORDER

Based on the representations made at the November 4, 2015 final pretrial conference, the Court hereby **ORDERS** the following.

- A. The bench trial in this case shall begin on **Monday, November 16, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.** Trial will adjourn on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 and resume the following day. The Court anticipates the trial to conclude on Tuesday, November 24, 2015.
- B. Unless otherwise noted below, any motions *in limine* shall be made at trial.
- C. The parties shall include in their trial briefs any briefing on Defendants' opposition to the introduction of non-testifying witness depositions for non-impeachment purposes. Plaintiffs shall provide to Defendants and the Court a list of the relevant deponents by **Friday, November 6, 2015.**

- D. The Court declines to exclude the testimony of Senator Nina Turner, Representative Michael Stinziano, and Douglas J. Preisse at this time. Defendants may, however, renew their objection at trial.
- E. The parties shall file any *Daubert* motions by **Thursday, November 12, 2015**. Responses are due **Sunday, November 15, 2015**. No replies will be permitted, and briefing is not to exceed ten pages.
- F. With respect to the issue of Defendants' request for documents and Plaintiffs' First Amendment objection thereto, Defendants shall file a motion to compel by **Friday, November 6, 2015 at 12:00 p.m.** Responses are due **Monday, November 9, 2015**. No replies will be permitted, and briefing is not to exceed ten pages.
- G. The parties are expected to meet and confer to resolve Defendants' objection to certain exhibits designated by Plaintiffs that Defendants claim were not produced during discovery. Plaintiffs shall provide to Defendants and the Court the legislative recordings and transcripts discussed at the conference.
- H. At this time, the Court will not permit any additional depositions regarding potential issues that arose with Direct Recording Electronic voting machines in Trumbull County, Ohio during the November 3, 2015 election.
