Parties, other than the League of Women Voters of Indiana and the League of Women Voters of Indianapolis, Indiana, who did not appear, appear by counsel for status conference. Conference held and concluded during which the parties report that the schedule previously ordered for dispositive motion briefing will be met by all parties and that the following discovery extensions WILL NOT impede or delay that schedule:

1. Because there was an agreed upon delay in the plaintiffs' expert disclosure, the defendants shall identify their experts by October 13, 2005, and shall provide the required experts' reports by October 31, 2005.

2. All discovery shall be completed by November 30, 2005.

In addition, plaintiffs are granted leave to file a brief in support of their motion for summary judgment not to exceed 60 days.

Finally, on the question of the motion to intervene, Magistrate Judge inquired as to whether there were any objections to the League of Women Voters being allowed to appear as an amicus, and file an amicus brief, if they choose to do so; there were no objections.
