**SCHEDULING ORDER**

Pursuant to the telephone conference held with the Court on this date, and the entire record herein, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows.

1. The government shall file its consolidated memorandum in opposition to [5] plaintiff's motion for summary judgment and in support of its cross-motion for summary judgment by not later than November 15, 2010. The government's consolidated memorandum shall not exceed seventy-five (75) pages in length.
2. Defendant-intervenors shall file their memoranda in opposition to [5] plaintiff's motion for summary judgment and in support of their cross-motions for summary judgment by not later than November 15, 2010. Each defendant-intervenor may file only one memorandum, which shall not exceed forty-five (45) pages in length. A defendant-intervenor may not file its own memorandum and also join another defendant-intervenor's cross-motion and memorandum. Defendant-intervenors are strongly encouraged, however, to file joint memoranda and to avoid

unnecessary duplication.

3. Plaintiff may file a consolidated reply memorandum in support of [5] its motion for summary judgment and in opposition to defendant's and defendant-intervenors' cross-motions for summary judgment by not later than December 13, 2010. Plaintiff's consolidated memorandum shall not exceed sixty-five (65) pages in length.
4. The government may file a reply memorandum in support of its cross-motion for summary judgment by not later than January 14, 2011. The government's reply shall not exceed thirty-five (35) pages in length.
5. The defendant-intervenors may file reply memoranda in support of their cross-motions for summary judgment by not later than January 14, 2011. The defendant-intervenors' reply memoranda shall not exceed twenty-five (25) pages in length, and they are again strongly encouraged to file joint memoranda and avoid duplication.
6. A motions hearing is scheduled for February 2, 2011, at 9:30 AM in Courtroom 8.
