It is hereby

ORDERED THAT:

1. Amended pleadings to be filed/additional parties to be joined by September 15, 2005;
2. Motion to dismiss to be filed by September 30, 2005; opposition due October 20, 2005; reply due October 31, 2005. Case no. 3:04cv7724 and 3:05cv7286 consolidated.
3. Rule 26 disclosures to be exchanged by September 30, 2005; leave granted to plaintiffs to file discovery requests pending adjudication of motion to dismiss; responses to such requests to be filed within two weeks of the date of adjudication of said motion;
4. Discovery re. summary judgment to be completed by May 1, 2006;
5. Motion for summary judgment to be filed May 15, 2006; opposition due June 5, 2006, reply

due June 15, 2006.

6. Non-jury trial set for August 22, 2006, at 8:30 a.m.

Motions in limine to be filed two weeks prior to trial; opposition to be filed one week prior to trial.

Not later than one week prior to trial, the parties are to:

Mark and exchange exhibits and exchange witness lists.

Provide the court reporter with the names of all counsel and witnesses, a copy of exhibits and a glossary of scientific, technical, or similar terms and terminology and to inform the court reporter whether daily copy or other special services are desired.

7. Final telephonic pretrial conference set for July 31, 2006, at 10:00 a.m.

8. Settlement conference to be held before United States Magistrate Judge at the request of any party.

All further proceedings are to be filed electronically. Failure of counsel to take all steps necessary to file and receive electronic pleadings, notices, and orders within four weeks of the CMC shall not be accepted as grounds for vacating any adverse action resulting from the non-receipt of any pleading, notice, or order that was filed by other counsel or the Court electronically.
