MOTION TO STRIKE


Plaintiff J. B. Van Hollen, acting in his official capacity as Attorney General of the State of Wisconsin, moves the Court for an order striking the "Motion of the Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights under Law, the Brennan Center for Justice, the Campaign Legal Center, Fair elections Wisconsin, and Professor Daniel P. Tokaji for Leave to Exceed Non-Party Brief Page Limits."

The grounds for this motion are that the Movants are not parties to this action and have not been granted leave to participate in the action as *amicus curiae*. Simply put, they have no

standing to file any motion with the Court other than a motion allowing them to participate. No such motion has been filed and there are likely significant issues to be decided with respect to any motion for leave to participate as *amicus curiae*.
