The Defendant Federal Election Commission is hereby temporarily restrained from enforcing the prohibition on corporate expenditures for electioneering communications at 2 U.S.C. § 441b as to WRTL's radio broadcast of the Advertisement set out as Exhibit D to the Third Affidavit of Barbara L. Lyons for 10 days from this Order.
