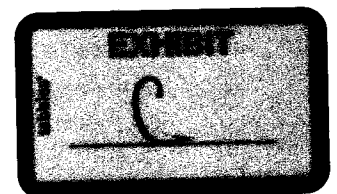


CHRISTY COLLEY  
DECLARATION OF JERRY YOUNG

1. My name is Christy Colley.
2. I am over 18 years old, a United States citizen, and a resident of Panola County, Mississippi.
3. I was convicted of embezzlement on 11-99.
4. I attempted to register and vote on 8/26/08 at 11:15 AM Panola County Courthouse, but was instructed that, because of my criminal conviction, I would have to first get my voting rights restored before being eligible to vote in the presidential election to be held on November 4, 2008.
5. I wish to vote in the November 4, 2008 presidential election, but am unable to do so because neither the Mississippi voter registration application form nor the



federal voter registration application form allow me to register only for the presidential and vice-presidential federal election.
