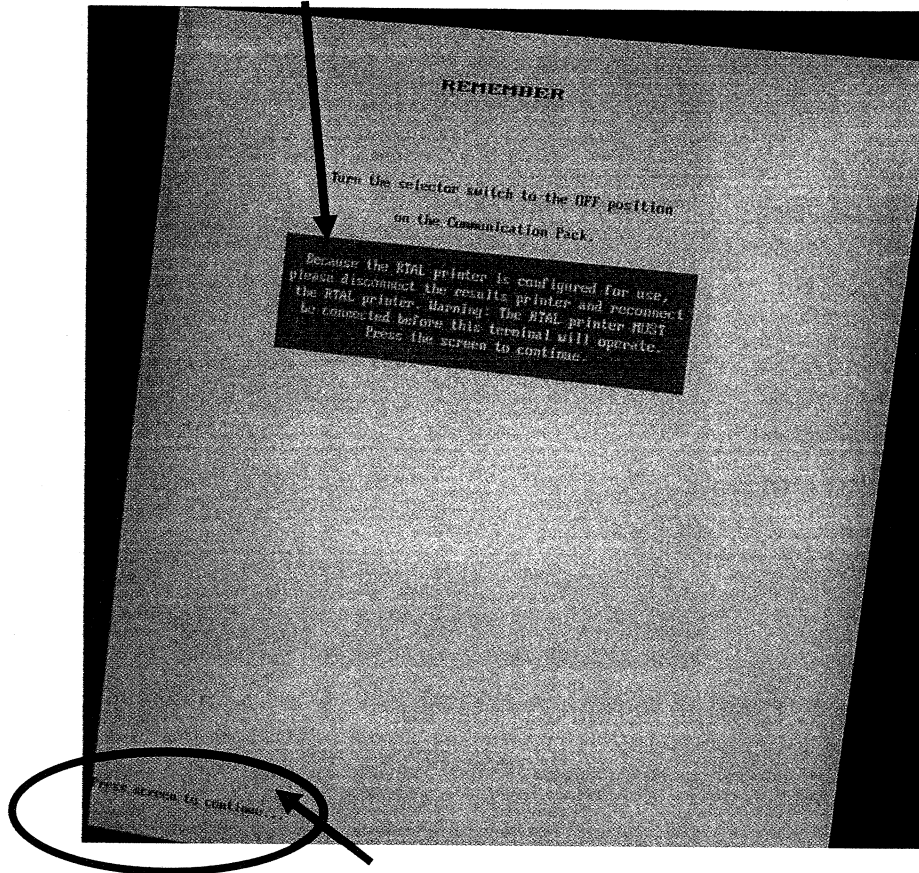
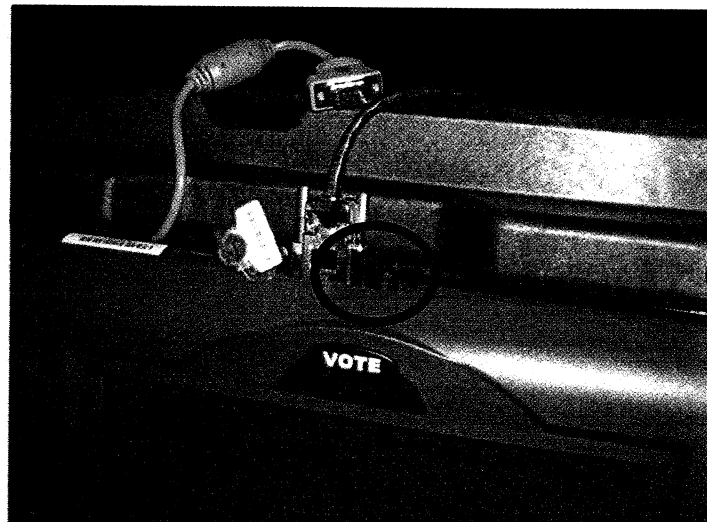


- 16. At a blue screen (with a blue box with text), you will be prompted to disconnect the portable printer.



- 17. Press the screen to continue

IT IS CRITICAL THAT THE BLACK POWER CABLE IS PUSHED IN FIRMLY AFTER RECONNECTING THE GRAY RTAL PRINTER CABLE.

- 18. Two reports will automatically print. If not, you will be asked if you want to print another report. (Only Press the green "PRINT" button one time and WAIT!)
- 19. After the reports are printed, press DONE.
- 20. Unplug the portable printer, and place it in the Voting Machine Supply Pack.
- 21. Each Precinct Election Official must sign both copies of the results tapes.
 - 1) Post one at the entrance to the polling location.
 - 2) Place one copy in the designated plastic pouch in the VOTR Book.

Only now are you ready to remove the green tamper safe security tape at the top of each machine.

- 22. Remove and discard the green tamper safe security tape covering the compact flash memory card from each machine.
- 23. Slide the door to expose each flash memory card.
- 24. Remove by pulling straight up on the plastic tab attached to each **compact flash memory card**, and place each of them in the designated plastic pouch of the **Voter Official Tabulation Results (VOTR) Book**.
- 25. The flash cards from each machine will be returned to the drop-off zone in the **Voter Official Tabulation Results Book** by the Presiding Judge.

Don't forget to retrieve ALL compact flash memory cards and return them to the zone! Only retrieve the cards after you have closed all machines and printed your results tapes. If for some reason you did not open a machine, you still must remove and return that machine's compact flash memory card with the others from the precinct. The number of compact flash memory cards will be listed on a sheet inside your Voter Official Tabulation Results Book.
