DECLARATION OF HAL JENKINS

COMES NOW, the declarant, Hal Jenkins, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746 and declares:

1. That I am Hal Jenkins and I reside in Noxubee County, Mississippi. I was a poll official at the Shuqualak precinct in Noxubee County, Mississippi on August 7, 2007.
2. On the morning of August 7, 2007 at the Shuqualak precinct as the voting machines were being set up I noticed along with Barbara Perry and Sonya Slaughter that the voting machines were not printing out the ballots. I aided Ms. Perry and Ms. Slaughter in both determining and correcting the problem that the machines were having.
3. As to the allegation that I voted multiple times it is simply untrue. The federal observer that makes that allegation does not give a specific time that I allegedly cast those votes or on which machines those votes were cast.
4. I told no one who to vote for on the day of the election.
5. I did not pass out any campaign literature to anyone the day of the election.
