DECLARATION OF HENRY LEE STEWART


COMES NOW, the declarant, Henry Lee Stewart, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746 and declares:

1. That I am Henry Lee Stewart and I reside in Noxubee County, Mississippi. I was a bailiff at the Prairie Point precinct in Noxubee County, Mississippi on August 7, 2007.
2. When I arrived the Federal observers were already inside of the Prairie Point station.
3. As the voters started to arrive in the polling place the Federal Observer would approach different voters asking questions and watching them as they voted.
4. Several voters approached me and complained that the Federal observers were impeding their ability to vote.
5. After several hours and several complaints, I approached the Federal observer and asked for identification.
6. After a short while the police arrived and I walked outside with the Federal observer who at that time showed her identification. It was at that time that I found out she was there to observe the election.
