**ORDER PRELIMINARILY ENJOINING THE HOLDING OF LOCAL ELECTIONS IN  
THE AUGUST 28, 2007 NOXUBEE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY RUNOFF**

Upon the joint recommendation of the United States and the Defendants Ike Brown and the Noxubee County Democratic Executive Committee (the NDEC), the Court orders that local elections in the August 28, 2007 Democratic Primary runoff be preliminarily enjoined until September 18, 2007. However, the August 7, 2007 Democratic Primary will proceed as originally scheduled.

The Court further orders that by August 13, 2007, the parties submit orders with memoranda of law proposing remedial relief to address the Voting Rights Act violations by Defendants Brown and the NDEC.
