


General Election. (Stipulation ¶ 1.) Plaintiffs also filed a Motion for Leave to file an Amended Complaint, which omits their request for any such relief. (*Id.* at ¶ 2; Mot. Leave Amend Compl.) For her part, Intervenor Defendant stipulated that she no longer wishes to proceed as a party to this case. (Stipulation ¶ 3.)

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), the Stipulation dismissed Plaintiffs' claims for relief relating to the 2008 General Election without an order from this Court. Accordingly, Intervenor Defendant Linda Harper-Brown's Motions to Dismiss and to Join Necessary Parties are DENIED as moot.
