**[PROPOSED] ORDER AND ENTRY
GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION
FOR EXPEDITED DISCOVERY**

Pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 26, 30, 33, 34 and 45, and for good cause shown, specifically, in order to permit the parties to prepare properly for the forthcoming hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, and because of the upcoming election, it is ORDERED that discovery in this matter shall be expedited as follows:

- (1) Defendant shall provide his initial disclosures under Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(1) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(2) on or before October 27, 2006;
 - (2) Defendant shall respond to Plaintiffs' first set of document requests and interrogatories by October 27, 2006;
 - (3) The Rule 30(b)(6) deposition of Defendant will be taken on October 31, 2006;
- and



- (4) The subpoenas to the Butler County Board of Elections, Cuyahoga County Board of Elections, the Franklin County Board of Elections, the Hamilton County Board of Elections, the Lucas County Board of Elections, the Mahoning County Board of Elections, the Montgomery County Board of Elections, the Stark County Board of Elections, the Trumbull County Board of Elections and the Warren County Board of Elections shall be responded to by October 30, 2006 and the depositions of these Boards of Elections shall take place by October 30, 2006.
