

BLACK LAW STUDENTS ASSOCIATION – JONES DAY JUDGE ROBERT M. DUNCAN SCHOLARSHIP

This is a one-year scholarship in the amount of \$10,000 to be awarded in furtherance of The Ohio State University Michael E. Moritz College of Law’s diversity mission with particular attention to, but not limited to, members of groups that have been historically underrepresented at the Moritz College of Law, such as African-Americans. The ideal applicant will have shown demonstrated interest or leadership with respect to communities of color. In addition to the cash award, the scholarship recipient will also receive mentorship opportunities with Jones Day attorneys during the recipient’s law school career at the Moritz College of Law.

To qualify for the scholarship, the applicant must receive, at minimum, a bachelor’s degree from an accredited four-year college prior to Fall Semester 2010 and must attend the Moritz College of Law starting in Fall Semester 2010. Proof of acceptance and enrollment at the Moritz College of Law is required before any funds will be disbursed to or on behalf of the selected applicant.
