1-3 credit hours

By special arrangement with a particular faculty member, and with the approval of the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, a student may undertake an individual project for credit. The work will be supervised by the faculty member concerned and will be graded on an S/U basis. The number of credit hours will vary in accordance with the magnitude of the project. Ordinarily, individual projects should be undertaken only when the subject matter involved is otherwise unavailable in the curriculum.

An independent study can fulfill the second writing requirement for graduation providing there is a substantial writing requirement similar to that of a 2 hour seminar. The sponsoring faculty person should indicate below if this project is to satisfy the student's second writing requirement for graduation.
