

Education Abroad and Fellowship Opportunities

We are extending the deadline to apply to all of our programs (short 2-weeks summer programs, semester programs, and yearlong programs). Fellowship applications will also be extended beyond March 1. - **Oxford Summer Study Abroad (application deadline extended to April 15)**
 - Oxford Summer Program (up to 6 credits) (total cost including tuition, fees, room and board, field trips, and speakers is \$7,600); June 30-Aug. 4. Read more [here](#); apply [here](#).

- **Short-Term (2-week) No-Credit Summer Programs (application deadline extended to April 15)**
 - For these two programs, the only expenses to you are flight, visa, and incidentals.
 - Southwest University of Political Science and Law, Chongqing, China (2 weeks with paid accommodation, meals, tuition, field trips) – late May
 - University of Brasilia, Brazil (2 weeks with paid tuition, local field trips, and free housing with host families) – late May

- **Semester Exchange Programs**
 - Regular semester tuition paid to OSU
 - Use your loan money to live abroad instead of Columbus
 - No additional expenses except flights/visas and incidentals

- **Concurrent LL.M. Program (yearlong program in Spain)**
 - Regular semester tuition paid to OSU
 - Use your loan money to live abroad instead of Columbus
 - No additional expenses except flights/visas and incidentals
 - Spend one of your three JD years in Spain and earn the Masters in European Business Law and your JD all in three years.
 - Universidad de Comillas, Madrid, Spain

- **International Fellowships for Moritz students**
 - Squire Patton Boggs Foundation Public Service Fellowship funds one 1L or 2L student to work in public service either in the US or abroad (\$5,000 total stipend)
 - Nadorff International Fund Fellowship funds one 1L or 2L student to work summer abroad (private sector), language fluency, demonstrated international interest (\$5,000 total stipend)
 - Squire Patton Boggs Sustained Impact Fellowship, summer in Puerto Rico, Spanish fluency required (\$5,000 total stipend)
 - Finn International Post-Graduate Service Fellowship funds one graduating student to work in public interest work outside of the US (\$60,000 total stipend).
