The Reinberger Foundation Fellowship in Prosecution providing funding for a one year post-graduate fellowship as a prosecutor allowing Moritz graduates to begin careers in criminal, civil or juvenile prosecution and trial practice.

The Finn Fellowship in International Law allows a Moritz graduate to spend a year abroad working in international service for a nonprofit organization or other similar entity.

The OCCH/Legal Aid Fellowship places a graduate in a one year fellowship with the Legal Aid Society of Columbus (LASC) in conjunction with the Community Properties of Ohio Initiative (CPO Initiative) assisting residents with legal issues that are common barriers to achieving stability and moving forward in their lives.
