JOINT MOTION TO CLARIFY DISCOVERY DEADLINES

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 29, the parties hereby move jointly to clarify the discovery deadline set out in the March 9, 2015 Order Granting the Joint Motion to Amend Discovery Deadlines in the three related cases, *North Carolina State Conference of the NAACP v. McCrory*, 1:13-cv-658 (M.D.N.C.); *League of Women Voters v. North Carolina*, 1:13-cv-660 (M.D.N.C.); and *United States v. North Carolina*, 1:13-cv-861 (M.D.N.C.). The March 9, 2015 Order, ECF 244, 13-cv-861, provides that “[a]ll discovery except for depositions shall be concluded by March 24, 2015.”

The parties are currently negotiating issues relating to the production of documents, in attempt to narrow or eliminate issues that may require resolution by this Court. The parties therefore move to clarify that, consistent with this Court’s March 9, 2015 scheduling order, any party to this case may file a motion to compel production of documents after March 24, 2015, on any requests for documents pending as of that date, if the parties are not able to resolve the matter among themselves.

A proposed order accompanies this motion.
