

SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF DELINDA BRYANT

My name is Delinda Bryant and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:

1. I ended up not voting by absentee ballot.
2. Getting that stamp was just too hard for me in terms of the cost of the stamp and being able to go out to the post office to get the stamp.
3. I have been staying in the house almost all the time since the pandemic started. A friend of mine goes grocery shopping for me. Dougherty county has been a COVID-19 hotspot, so I don't want to risk leaving the house. A friend of mine was hospitalized after getting COVID-19.
4. Before the primary election, I stayed for about a month with my daughter who lives in Atlanta. We were worried that it might not be safe for me to stay in Dougherty county since the virus was getting so bad in the county.
5. Before the primary election, my daughter brought me back to Dougherty county because I had to vote in-person.
6. On Election Day, my daughter took me to the polling site. I made sure to wear a mask since I was going out that day.
7. My polling location was at a school gym, so I thought there would be plenty of space to spread out the voting machines. But when I got inside the gym, the voting machines were very close together.

8. I had to wait in the gym for about an hour. I was uncomfortable about waiting in the gym for so long because the voting machines were so close together and because there were a lot of people not wearing masks in the building.

9. Through my civic engagement work, I also heard from many people who had trouble filling out their absentee ballots. Since there are a lot of people in the community who haven't had a lot of education, I heard from many people who struggled to fill out their absentee ballots properly.
