


DECLARATION OF IRIS HUDSON

My name is Iris Hudson and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:

1. I am a registered Georgia voter and resident in Fulton county.
2. I am a United States citizen and am 49 years old. I have not been declared mentally incompetent by a judge, and I am not currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
3. I submitted an application for an absentee ballot in at the beginning of April, but never received a ballot in the mail.
4. I wanted to vote absentee because of the threat of coronavirus.
5. As a cancer survivor who also has diabetes and high blood pressure issues, I have a heightened risk for complications if I get the coronavirus infection.
6. I have been practicing social distancing measures and wearing masks anytime I leave the house.
7. Because I never received an absentee ballot in the mail, I had to vote in-person on Election Day.
8. I waited for approximately two hours in line to vote that day.
9. I felt uneasy about voting with my medical conditions. I felt like I was putting myself at a greater risk by having to vote in-person.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
