

DECLARATION OF CHRISTINE LEGNON

My name is Christine Legnon and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:

1. I am a registered Georgia voter and resident in Fulton county.
2. I am a United States citizen and am 45 years old. I have not been declared mentally incompetent by a judge, and I am not currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
3. I am a massage therapist and had recently started a business before the pandemic started. In order to keep my employees and customers safe, I had to shut down my business shortly after I started. I only reopened my business on June 17, 2020.
4. I am facing serious financial hardships because of the economic downturn caused by COVID-19.
5. I wanted to vote through absentee ballot, but since I had recently moved and did not have stamps in my house, I decided I should vote in-person.
6. I am not really leaving the house much right now, but when I do I make sure to wear a mask.
7. On Election Day, I got in line at my polling place around 7:00 a.m. The line was already pretty long by then.

8. We had all kinds of weather while we were waiting in line. At some points it was really sunny, and at other points it was raining a little bit.
9. No poll workers were enforcing any social distancing when I got in line. It was mainly just people on their own who were making sure they were staying six feet apart.
10. Once I got inside the building where we were supposed to vote, there was some tape on the ground showing where we were supposed to stand to make sure we didn't crowd the volunteer workers.
11. I had to wait in line for about four hours and 20 minutes to vote on Election Day.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
