

**DECLARATION OF AL LEWIS**

My name is Al Lewis and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:

1. I am a registered Georgia voter and resident in DeKalb county.
2. I am a United States citizen and am 43 years old. I have not been declared mentally incompetent by a judge, and I am not currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
3. I was born with spina bifida, a disability that has impacted the development of my spinal cord. Because of my condition, I had to have both of my legs amputated and I now use a power wheelchair to move around.
4. I live with my partner, Renita, who has cerebral palsy. Renita also uses a power wheelchair to move around.
5. Because of my disability, I rely on Supplemental Security Income (“SSI”) benefits.
6. I have a home health aide who comes daily to run errands for me and helps me cook and clean the home.
7. I applied to get an absentee ballot for the primary election because of the COVID-19 pandemic. I have basically been completely homebound since the pandemic hit, so I didn’t want to leave the house to go vote in-person.

8. I received my absentee ballot and was able to return the ballot before the deadline for the primary election.
9. I wasn't sure how many stamps I was supposed to put on the ballot envelope. I put one stamp on the envelope, but I was a little concerned whether that would be enough.
10. Thankfully I had some stamps in the house because my home health aide buys a booklet for me every month or so when she is running errands for me.
11. If I didn't have the stamps at home and my home health aide couldn't get it for me, it would be difficult for me to get stamps. I would probably have to take the MARTA or schedule a van to pick me up to take me to the post office.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
