


DECLARATION OF MARQUIS JUNIOR

My name is Marquis Junior and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:

1. I am a registered Georgia voter and resident in Fulton county.
2. I am a United States citizen and am 26 years old. I have not been declared mentally incompetent by a judge, and I am not currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
3. I wanted to vote by absentee ballot this year because of the pandemic, but I've moved around a lot in the past year, and I wasn't sure if I'd get my absentee ballot at the right address if I applied for one.
4. I thought about early voting so I wouldn't have to face the crowds on election day, but all the early voting locations were pretty far from where I live. It would have cost me about \$70 roundtrip to take an Uber or a Lyft to go and come back from an early voting location.
5. I have been unemployed since March 14, 2020. I am also a recent college graduate, so saving money is really important to me right now.
6. On Election Day, I walked to my local polling place. The long was already very long when I got there.

7. I had to wait in line for about 2 hours. During those two hours, it was raining at some points, and then got really hot at other points. There were no chairs for people to wait in line.
