


DECLARATION OF PABLO TEJADA BASSOLS

My name is Pablo Tejada Bassols and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:

1. I am a registered Georgia voter and resident in Fulton county.
2. I am a United States citizen and am 35 years old. I have not been declared mentally incompetent by a judge, and I am not currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
3. I applied for an absentee ballot on May 7, 2020.
4. I wanted to vote through absentee ballot because of the COVID-19 pandemic. My wife and I have been social distancing as much as possible, and I didn't want to expose myself to a lot of people if there was a way I could vote through the mail.
5. I never received an absentee ballot.
6. Because I never received an absentee ballot in the mail, I decided to vote in-person on Election Day.
7. I arrived at my polling location a little bit before 7:00 a.m.
8. When I got in line, there weren't any poll workers making sure we were social distancing. There were some people who were staying six feet apart, but others who were not.
9. It took me about four hours to vote in-person that day.

10. Even if I had gotten my absentee ballot, I would have had to break my social distancing routine. I don't have any stamps at home because I never use them. I've probably sent two or three letters in my entire life. I don't know how many stamps I would have had to put on the ballot. I probably would have gone to a FedEx to send the ballot back.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
