

DECLARATION OF SAMUEL KUTTIG

My name is Samuel Kuttig and I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the following:


1. I am a registered Georgia voter and resident in Fulton county.
2. I am a United States citizen and am 28 years old. I have not been declared mentally incompetent by a judge, and I am not currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction.
3. I work as an associate at a bank. I have been working from home since early March of 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. I have also been taking social distancing measures. I try not to leave the house if possible.
4. I applied for an absentee ballot in early May of 2020. My girlfriend and I got our applications for an absentee ballot around the same time. We both filled it out at the same time, but she chose to mail in her application and I emailed my application.
5. My girlfriend got her ballot in a few weeks. But I never received my absentee ballot.
6. I checked the My Voter Page, and it said that my request for a ballot had been received and that my absentee ballot was issued on June 1, 2020.
7. To this day I have not received my absentee ballot.

8. Because I never received my ballot, I had to go vote in-person on Election Day.

9. Although it didn't take me a long time to vote that day, I had to spend some time inside the polling location figuring out where to go. I had to spend some time getting poll workers' attention so I could go where I needed to go.

10. If I had voted through absentee ballot, I would have borrowed stamps from my girlfriend. I don't usually have stamps at home, so if it wasn't for my girlfriend I would have needed to figure out where to get stamps. I can't even remember the last time I had to mail something out.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
