**UNOPPOSED EMERGENCY MOTION
FOR LEAVE TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE***

Pursuant to Local Rule 7.1(L), the National Republican Senatorial Committee, a prospective intervenor, respectfully moves the Court to permit Thomas H. Dupree, Jr., an attorney with Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher LLP in Washington, D.C., to appear and argue on an emergency basis at the telephonic hearing scheduled for 4 P.M. today, though time constraints do not permit him to complete the tutorial requirements of the Northern District's local rules before this afternoon's hearing.

1. The NRSC has retained Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher LLP and GrayRobinson, P.A., to represent it in this matter.

Given the immediacy of the hearing in this matter and the emergent nature of the election canvassing at issue in this litigation, the NRSC respectfully requests the Court to permit Mr. Dupree to appear and argue at the hearing this afternoon and subsequently to complete the remaining requirements of pro hac vice admission set forth in the Local Rules.

WHEREFORE, the National Republican Senatorial Committee respectfully moves the Court to permit Thomas H. Dupree, Jr., to appear and argue on an emergency basis at the telephonic hearing scheduled for 4 P.M. today.
